



City of Show Low Adopt-A-Street Guidelines

Only volunteers who have read these safety rules may be involved in the litter pickup.

1. Clean-up activity should only occur during daylight hours. No clean up should take place during bad weather.
2. Please contact the Adopt-A-Street coordinator at 928-532-4100 prior to beginning and immediately following your scheduled pick-up.
2. No volunteers shall be under age 10. One adult supervisor shall be provided for each five workers under age 18.
3. Carpooling is recommended to reduce roadside parking.
4. Volunteers must stay out of the lanes of traffic; work on the same side of the street and cross to the other side at intersections with caution. Construction areas are to be avoided. Stay away from parked vehicles and equipment.
5. For the protection of all workers, safety vests, gloves, long pants and thick-soles shoes must be worn. The city will provide safety vests. Workers should face oncoming traffic when picking up litter. Be alert for snakes, stinging/biting insects, and poisonous plants.
6. A first aid kit and cellular phone must be available to volunteers during the clean-up. An adequate supply of drinking water and insect repellent are recommended.
7. Do not touch or pick up items that you may feel are hazardous or contaminated.
8. All safety vests and un-used trash bags should be returned to the City.
9. After completing your pick-up efforts, please place all used trash bags and other debris alongside the road and out of the traffic way. Contact the Adopt-A-Street Coordinator at 928-532-4100 so that we may have the trash removed.
